OUR SUMMER INTERNS

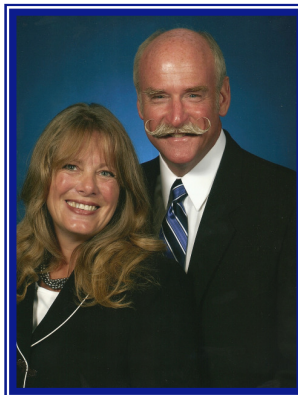
